THE RIGHT LOAD FOR A FISHING ROD IN THE DRILL!

The power of a rod lies in the hand section, the tip determines sensitivity, responsiveness and casting characteristics!


Because knowledge simply catches more and more fish, we would like to illustrate how a fishing rod should be loaded correctly and how breakages can be avoided:

You've done it! A fish has taken your bait and you have successfully set the hook. The fight, by far the most exciting part of our fishing trips, begins.

All your skills will be required over the next few minutes, and in very rare cases even hours, to let the potential dream fish slide into the landing net. To ensure that the strong opponent tires quickly, it is best to heed the following tips: depending on the rod action and fighting strength of the fish, you will achieve the best load distribution when the rod is bent right into the hand section and the angle of inclination is below 45 degrees. In this target state, each rod section can optimally fulfil its task.


Tips:

- If you have a 'hanger', hold the rod flat, close the brake and apply tension solely via the line. This prevents the rod from being overloaded or even breaking! You also increase the chance of releasing the hook, as the line exerts the pressure directly on the lure without your rod acting as a spring against it.
- Release the drag during transport: Not only does this protect your drag discs in the long term, but it can also effectively prevent rod breakage. How does this work? Just imagine you get caught with the line, ring or hook of the lure in the boot of the car or in the bank vegetation. In this case, the lightly adjusted drag can release the line - there is no tension that would cause the rod to bend over unintentionally. This is completely different with a hard brake setting!
- Rod section connections should be checked regularly. Even if you plug your rod parts together with precisely measured force, any temperature differences between day and night or high loads can cause the carbon to expand or shrink. This can loosen the connections in the long term, which can lead to breakage.
- The steeper the angle, the less pressure the rod can exert on the fish and the less you make it work for you.
- Remember that your rod is a finely tuned piece of high-performance sports equipment and not a clumsy 'broomstick' on which you can lift your fish out of the water.
- Especially when the dream fish is within reach, many anglers 'instinctively' tend to pull the rod tip behind the head/shoulder and thus position it far too 'steeply'.
 If a fish that is not fully drilled out then makes a spontaneous escape attempt, this often results in unsightly tip breaks - and the joy turns into the opposite.
- A net or landing net should always be used to land a fish. If you don't have one to hand, it is always worth landing the fish using the leader instead of the rod. Roughly speaking: the tip catches, the hand part drills.





There is a risk on the flip side of optimising the load on the rod: Set the rod angle steeper than 45 degrees, say, and not only will the pulling power and drill power decrease to the extent that the risk of suffering a rod breakage increases. So: Never stretch the rod steeply upwards or even backwards! With extremely strong fish, it can make sense to support the end of the rod at the hip and brace yourself against the fish with the rod in order to increase your power reserves.

PREDATOR FISHING IN AUTUMN!

Every season has its own character. In spring, nature comes back to life and anglers look forward to being back on the water after the sometimes long closed seasons. Summer allows us to go after our target fish in T-shirt and shorts, at least as long as the mosquitos don't put a spanner in the works.

However, the last rainy days of summer soon herald the cooler autumn. Our cold-blooded fish notice this immediately and know that it is now time to prepare for the approaching winter. The supposedly big feeding season begins and thus a time when we anglers can expect good chances on the water. We have summarised the most important tips for autumn so that you are successful this time of year.



The colder it gets, the more bait fish such as roach, burbot and co. move closer together. For us, of course, this means that predators also move into the bait fish areas. They can catch a lot of prey here with relatively little energy expenditure. Often these gatherings can still be recognised visually on the surface or, unfortunately, by hunting cormorants. But it's not just the white fish that are gathering now. Perch are also gathering in ever larger numbers as the temperatures gradually get colder. If you catch one now, you should work the spot for longer so that you can possibly outwit several specimens.



2. Larger lures lead to success

In contrast to spring, the fry have not just hatched, but have already grown a few centimetres. In other words, the general prey of predatory fish has become significantly larger. Furthermore, as the water gets colder, pike and co. naturally want to spend less and less effort on their food. They often prefer to attack one larger fish rather than three small ones.



3. Be well dressed

Of course, we are not talking about designer clothes or stylish outfits. Rather, we recommend being prepared for a wide range of weather conditions. October has seen everything from 20 degrees and sunshine to snowfall. An extra rain jacket in the car just in case, or a T-shirt under a jumper, can make or break a long day's fishing. Generally speaking, a change of clothes in the car is never a bad idea. Who hasn't slipped on the bank or fallen off the boat and involuntarily gone for a swim...



4. Fishing into the night sometimes

This is not necessarily the best strategy if you're after perch. Even if this can work in exceptional cases, zander and pike are better target fish in the dark. Zander are extremely intelligent night predators and pike will also find a powerful lure with lots of pressure waves, even in the darkest of nights. The most productive time is often from sunset until around 22:00 or 24:00 at the latest. Of course, you should know your water and the locations of the fish well for night-time spin fishing. Certainly not a tip for everyone, but anyone who has always toyed with the idea should definitely give it a try. It is often the case that the more fishing pressure there is on the water, the better it works.

5. Autumn is not the end...

Even if the cold weather in November and December means the end of the fishing season, it is often worth continuing to spend time on the water during these months. When the smaller specimens reduce their feeding, the larger ones are often still dependent on more reserves. So it's best not to stow away your fishing tackle early.

PERCH FISHING IN THE COLD SEASON!

Contrasts for catching success!

Even if it takes a little longer here and there, autumn and winter will definitely arrive. Low temperatures, rain and generally more uncomfortable than sunny days now characterise our everyday lives and fishing. Some people have already winterised their fishing tackle and declared the season over. However, this can turn out to be a mistake, especially when targeting perch. They start to gather in shoals in early autumn. They are no longer found in small numbers in many places, but certain spods are now often taken by large numbers of fish. This of course has great advantages, but also disadvantages. The advantage is that if we know the spots, it is often possible to catch several specimens at the same time and they are also very loyal to the location.

In other words, if the weather conditions or the water level (in the river) do not change significantly, you can achieve good results in the same places over several weeks. However, the disadvantage here is obvious: the spots have to be found first. In this article, we would like to tell you how to do this and why the title is 'Contrasts for fishing success'.





The right spot

Let's make one thing clear right away. It is never easy to find these 'perch nests'. Whether from the bank without any aids or from a boat with various electronic devices. A lot of distance has to be fished in order to track down the fish. The first important clue here is the depth of the water. The perch are not shallow, at least not in Germany. Although we often hear this from our neighbouring country Holland, the picture is often different in German waters. The perch retreat to the deeper and calmer areas, as the water is warmer here and the oxygen content suits them better. It is important to the fish that they do not have to expend too much energy on the hunt. In other words, the forage fish should at least be in the vicinity. So if you know where the small forage fish such as burbot, roach or gobies are located, you are already on the right track. Cormorants, which have unfortunately been hanging around in recent years, especially in winter, often give this away. Due to the preference of perch for warmer and oxygen-rich water, the hotspots do not necessarily have to be on edges, sunken trees or similar apparently good spots. Sometimes the fish are now in places that have tended to be less productive all year round. If you pay attention to this, you will be able to pick 'cherries' sooner or later. Those who fish specifically in the river will often find fish in harbours and other quiet areas in winter.

The methods and baits

As we have already mentioned, perch, like all other fish species, are in energysaving mode in winter. In other words, if possible, they don't want to make a big effort for a successful hunt. When it comes to baiting, this clearly means that slow is the key! And by slow, we really mean extremely slow in some cases. We would like to take a closer look at two very contrasting methods below, which will also explain our title. The first is the Carolina Rig, which allows a very passive presentation of the bait close to the bottom. Secondly, we want to explain fishing with twitchbaits in more detail.

The Carolina Rig

This leader/rig, which can be assembled with just a few small parts and fluorocarbon, is fished with both crayfish imitations and rubber fish. If both are available to the striped predators in the water, you simply have to test what suits their current taste. Some of them are not picky, but especially in winter, they tend to favour one type of food. For us, this means that the bait box often has to be tried out until a catchy bait is found.

Otherwise, the application is relatively simple. Cast it out, let it sink and then retrieve it with regular pauses. You can also drag the lead or bait very slowly over the bottom with the rod tip. Bites from large perch often come especially during the pauses. They love to suck the paused bait off the bottom. Thin lines and sensitive rods help to ensure success here.

Twitchbaits

Now for a stark contrast, the twitchbaits/wobblers. These lures are characterised by the fact that they are guided quite wildly so that they jump from one side to the other at lightning speed. Proper strikes in the rod ensure the zigzag run of the lure. Of course, you might think that this type of fishing is not very successful for sluggish predators. However, if you adapt your style of fishing, this method can work extremely well.

It is important to incorporate long pauses between movements. So if you animate the lure with three to four strokes in summer before waiting a short time, only one 'jerk' may be enough in the cold season. In other words, jerk - pause, jerk - pause, jerk - pause, jerk - pause...

As with the Carolina Rig, the bites often come at the moment when the bait pauses motionless. The rods should be slightly flexible for this type of fishing so that the strikes do not hit the lure too hard and cause it to roll over. Subtle jumps from left to right tend to be better in cold water. It is important to mention here that pike are often hooked as by-catch on these lures in particular. A titanium tip is therefore highly advisable so as not to jeopardise either the fish

or the expensive bait.

ADDITIONAL TIP:

You don't need many of the often expensive lures. A shallow plus deep runner in a natural design and the same in more eye-catching patterns are usually sufficient to cover the most common situations. Especially with the eye-catching designs, you should look out for an orange belly, which perch particularly like in winter.

Sometimes things just don't work out. You can do whatever you want, but somehow nothing works out as planned. That's exactly what happened to me! In spring, all sorts of little things kept me away from the water and I rarely made it out fishing. Later on, I had the time again, but just couldn't really get into the year. Despite a few nights out, the result was more than manageable and I racked my brains as to what could be the reason. As lost self-confidence and doubt were never the best ingredients for success, the more I thought and questioned things, the worse things went. A real downward spiral! But several times in the past, it was precisely those moments when I would have liked to have thrown everything away that were followed by something special. So I kept brooding, spent even more nights out and secretly hoped for a miracle or at least some luck that would steer me back on the right track.



When the sun once again waked me at 5 a.m. due to the short nights and no more bream or tench seemed to be interested in my bait, I slowly accepted my fate. The hot weather, the clear nights and the constantly high air pressure heralded the arrival of summer and were certainly not the best conditions for maximum success. Despite everything, I decided to stay another night, because why not? It couldn't get any worse anyway! At least the mosquitoes were really active. After the work was done and with the prospect of another blank night, I wanted to walk around the lake to stretch my legs. As an angler, you do this with polarised glasses of course, there's always something interesting to see. As well as a small pike close to the reeds, I also found a few white fish flitting around the shore. In a shallow bay, I also spotted a few schools of small carp moving around just below the surface, presumably gathering to spawn. It couldn't be long now before spring would finally be replaced by summer. Just a short distance away, I spotted another group of carp, but they obviously had other things on their minds: Eating! Just a few metres from the bank in waist-deep water, four fish ploughed through the sediment. These included

two beautiful scaly fish weighing an estimated 15-17kg, a mirror with a good 20kg and an absolute giant of a scaly carp. I was petrified when I saw how it calmly moved around to examine the stones and mud for food. When it turned away, I could see the full dimensions of the fish. Not only was it long, but it was also incredibly wide and had a prominent pot belly. An absolutely impressive animal! Again and again, the fish came right up to the shore, then turned away and disappeared into the deep water, only to approach again a little later from a different spot. Fascinated, I followed the action from a safe distance and with some cover. After watching for a while, the question finally occurred to me: Would it be possible to catch the fish? Would I scare them off immediately if I approached or something touched the water? I decided to at least give it a try. The sun was already low and I knew that the window of opportunity for



the fish to be here was slowly closing. They wouldn't be here for long and the increasingly long pauses in which they stayed in the deep water were a clear indication of this.

I sprinted back to the car, threw the most necessary items into the large unhooking mat and made my way back to the water as guickly as possible with the oversized carrier bag. When I arrived at the spot, I realised they were still there! But what would be the best way to go about it? How could I outwit one? How could I outwit HIM? Because secretly I didn't want to catch just any fish, I wanted to catch HIM, the huge scaly. How could I pick him out of the group? Would I even be able to catch one of the fish? Things were going rather badly for me at the moment. So perhaps I should consider myself lucky with every success. Nevertheless, I could try to do everything I could to perhaps be lucky enough to catch that one fish. Consequently, I did everything I could to match its behaviour as closely as possible. I put a single 20mm liver boilie on the hair, which was barely distinguishable from the background in terms of colour, so as not to arouse any suspicion. I also shortened my leader by 5cm, as the fish was searching the bottom intensively, but hardly moved when it seemed to have come across something edible. It was also noticeable that all four fish always moved together from the deeper water into the shallows, but the other fish had searched an area relatively quickly and were already retreating again. The big fish seemed to be more dominant than the others when it came to feeding, searched longer and also came closer to the bank. I wanted to capitalise on this and put all my eggs in one basket. So I waited until the fish seemed to have largely searched a strip of bank and only two carp were still actively searching, including my chosen target fish. When they turned a few metres towards the middle of the lake again, I carefully crept a few steps closer to the bank and silently placed my rig directly under the rod tip. The lure was now less than two metres from the bank in less than half a metre of water. I left the line very slack so that it could sink completely to the bottom and finally placed the rod in front of me with the drag open. I didn't even think about a second rod, the risk of spooking the fish was too great. Could something like this work? Even as I was sitting in the grass thinking this, the huge fish reappeared from the depths of the water, accompanied by one of the smaller scup. Its body mass was no accident and it was still eagerly searching the bottom. As both approached my bait, my breath caught in my throat. They were now supposedly directly above the lure and seemed to be lowering their heads downwards. However, the colour of my lure was so inconspicuous that not even I could see exactly where it was between the fish. I knew I only had this one chance. No matter which fish I hooked, the spook would be over and the spot would be empty. Shortly afterwards, however, the fish slowly turned away again and I could see the full width of the big scaly once more. What a fish! Very slowly and with powerful strokes, it swam away from the spot. Damn! That was it, the one chance! It would have been too good to see such a coup after the dry spell. It would have been too good to have such a coup after the dry spell.

It was even more annoying that none of the fish had hooked themselves, even though they were feeding right next to my bait. Maybe they had noticed something after all or maybe my rig was the problem? Still feeling sorry for myself, I saw out of the corner of my eye that another fish was approaching from the right. As soon as I recognised it, it was already right by my bait, turned and suddenly froze. A few wild headbutts followed and the fish shot away. I immediately looked at my reel. Absolute silence. For a fraction of a second, absolutely nothing happened, then the line was hastily pulled down metre by metre. It had worked! I immediately picked up the rod and gently slowed down the fish, which naturally tried to get away first. After an initial flurry, it now calmly made its way along the bank. I couldn't see exactly which fish had hooked itself, everything happened so quickly and seemed somehow unreal. But I guessed it was one of the two smaller scup.

The strike behaviour also indicated this and the fish was soon back near the bank. This time, however, rather involuntarily. However, when a huge head suddenly broke through the water and a huge mass of fish turned under the surface, I knew it wasn't the small scamp! It's him! I've got him! A little later, I was finally able to pull the huge scaly carp over the edge of the landing net and had to make an effort to get it all the way in despite the actually large net. He seemed to be just as surprised as I was. Once in the landing net, I realised how big it really was. It left the 25kg I had hoped for far behind and the scales levelled out at just over 30kg. In the setting sun, we captured this moment with the camera in the most beautiful light. The fish never left the water and I stood exactly where the fish had bitten in the photos, wearing shorts and barefoot. In knee-deep water, less than two metres from the shore. The evening sun was shining on my face. What a moment! What an experience! Fishing will always be something magical....



The optimum rod length

Carp rods with a length of 12 ft. are among the classics.

To get significantly more out of your casts, you can switch to the slightly longer 13 ft. variant. The significantly longer lever arm accelerates the lead and the rig more, allowing you to cast a few metres further in the end.

A good casting technique

The right technique is crucial for converting your muscle power into acceleration. Extend your arms, lift your front leg and take a step forwards during the casting movement to convert all your strength into casting distance. Practise as often as possible and improve your throwing technique. Practice makes perfect!

The right test curve

Distance rods usually have test curves between 3.5-3.75 lbs.

With the significantly tighter action and faster recovery, you will achieve further and more accurate casts! Our Sportex carp rods now offer special 3-5 oz. Distance versions, which are available in many rod series. We particularly recommend these to long distance casters and distance professionals.



The right lead shape

The further you want to cast, the more important the details become. We recommend lead shapes such as Distance, Heli Square Pear or other aerodynamically optimised versions. Experience has shown that the ideal lead weights for long casts are between 100 and 140 grams.

The right line

Coordinate your setup in terms of line too. A thin braided line or thin monofilament lines are ideal for long distance casts. Thinner line diameters generate significantly less friction in the rod rings and reduce the air resistance of the line when casting. For example, diameters of 0.18 mm are suitable for braided lines and 0.28 mm for monofilament main lines.



The long cast booster

In the end, it is important to pay attention to the details. We recommend treating monofilament lines with Greased Lightning for optimisation and additional casting metres.

The Kryston agent creates the effect of reducing the friction of the main line. A cool side effect of its use is the increased abrasion resistance.



Be careful with violent casts!

Be careful and protect your fingers when casting with force. We recommend a leather finger guard for both braided and monofilament lines. They generate even more force with the finger guard and protect your fingers from injury

METHOD FEEDER FOR TENCH

By David Kraushaar

1. Your fishing spot

The right water is crucial for successful fishing. Therefore, find out beforehand whether tench have already been caught there. Once you arrive at the 'tench water,' open areas in herb fields, water lilies or reed beds are very interesting. Take your time and observe the water. It is not uncommon to spot feeding tench on a carpet of bubbles on the surface. They are most active in the early morning or late evening hours.

2. The bait

Before fishing begins, I distribute a handful of tinned corn at the fishing spot. Less is more here. I use special method feeder bait for the basket as this has better adhesive properties. I like to experiment with the flavour, e.g. one rod fishy, the other fruity/sweet. I have also had very good experiences with hemp flavouring.

3. The method feeder rig

Float fishing for tench is super exciting fishing, but in my opinion, fishing with a self-hooking rig is easier and more efficient, with the bait lying directly in or on the food. Especially with the cautious bites of tench, the false bite rate is lower. When the bite comes, it really gets going straight away. I use a sturdy hook, size 14, and wind the boilie onto a hair rig.

I tie the leader to a length of approx. 20cm. Another advantage of a feeder rig is the better casting distance, which means you can also target more distant hotspots. I set the rod tip flat and activate a bite indicator.

4. The bait

Tench love maggots and worms, but unfortunately so do many other fish species. That's why my favourite here is the mini boilie. Maggots and worms are quickly picked up or sucked out by whitefish. The mini boilie remains attractive for longer and can be easily hidden in the food. Here too, there is usually a boilie with a fishy flavour on one rod and a fruity/sweet flavour on the other.

5. The by-catch

Other fish species cannot be completely ruled out, but with the mini boilies it tends to be larger fish. However, these are always welcome. Tench are great fighters that demand everything from the equipment, but I'm also really happy about nice gills, bream or carp.


